HEALTH PROMOTION & EDUCATION

SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH



Botswana like many other developing countries is faced with challenges of increasing incidences and prevalence of preventable diseases, both communicable and non-communicable. The advent of HIV/AIDS has negatively impacted the already overstrained health workforce, hence, the need to strengthen their capacity to effectively address these challenges.

Health Promotion and Education strategies remain pivotal in influencing individuals and communities to make informed choices related to their health. Unlike the curative model of health HPE implements cost effective interventions to help effectively prevent and control diseases and ill health within communities.





Rec Degree in Health Promotion and Education

The Degree in Health Promotion and Education is designed to provide students with learning experiences which will assist them to achieve desirable understanding, attitudes and practices related to critical health issues. This will enable them to completely impart knowledge and skills to the community; and by so doing increase the options available to populations to exercise more control over their own health, environment and to make the right informed choices. The programme is designed to enable graduates to effectively and efficiently assess community needs and design appropriate health interventions.

Duration : 4 years, full time Admission : 36 points Part 1 : Course work Part 2 : Attachment & Research

Diploma in Health Promotion and Education

The Diploma in Health Promotion and Education is a 2-year full time course running through 4 semesters: spread over course work, research and a 13 weeks field attachment. This programme has its conceptual framework embodied in the Primary Health Care Model, of which the government of Botswana has committed itself to in order to promote the good health of its people. The programme is designed to enable graduates to work effectively and efficiently in a variety of settings such as District Health Management Teams, Schools, healthcare settings and non-governmental organizations.

Duration: 2 years, full time Admission: 34 points Part 1 : Course work, Research Part 2 : Attachment

Certificate in Health Education Assistance

The Certificate in Health Education Assistance is a 1 year full time course running through two semesters. The programme consists of course work component and industrial attachment.

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY



SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Following the world's fast growing economy and flourishing mining, construction and manufacturing industries; Boitekanelo College has recognized the need to offer programmes in Occupational Health and Safety. The programmes were designed to equip learners with the necessary knowledge and skills to address the health and safety issues in the workplace in order to prevent and eliminate the burden ofwork related injuries and diseases.

The Occupational Health and Safety programme is based on real work experiential learning, where students have the opportunity to be attached to different industries and health care facilities to assesssafety indicators and also to do hazard identification and risk assessments. The programmes have been designed to promote the wellbeing of workers in their respective workplace, which will yield valuable results such as improving employee morale, reducing absenteeism, increasing productivity as well ascutting cost arising from occupational injuries and compensation.





Bcc Degree in Occupational Health and Safety

The programme aims to build a pool of professionals who are capable of identifying, evaluating, assessing and controlling occupational hazards, risks and injuries to workers in all sectors of the economy. The programme will also hinge on protection of the environment and neighbouring communities. It further equips students with the skills to manage resources that are fundamental in the development of occupational health and safety plans and intervention programmes that promote wellness and safety at the workplace.

Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety

The Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety runs for two years on a full time basis, or three years on a part time basis. The programme structure depends on the mode of study, but students can expect to study a combination of coursework and research components on full time or part time depending on the mode of study.

Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety

The Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety programme is a one year full time course running over two semesters. The programme comprise of twenty eight (28) intensive lecture series and twelve (12) weeks of industrial attachment to relevant prospective workplaces in both public and private sector.

HEALTHCARE MANAGEMENT

SCHOOL OF ALLIED HEALTH



With growth in the diversity of the healthcare system, healthcare managers are needed in many settings including clinics, health insurance organizations, hospitals, public health departments, universities and research institutions. They are commonly responsible for health information, medical staff relations, nursing administration, healthcare administrations and patient care services.

Botswana's healthcare system needs skilled human resource in healthcare management to meet increasing healthcare demand which have been nfluenced by the HIV/AIDS pandemic and other contemporary healthcare issues. Healthcare Management has been more essential in Botswana due to the rapid changing healthcare environment-advancing technology, shrinking and scarce resources as well as demands placed on the system by healthcare consumers, policy holders and regulators.

BA Degree in Healthcare Service Management

The objective of the programme is to provide an education that is both intellectually challenging and directly relevant to the field of healthcare management. The programme is designed to provide students with concepts, models, techniques and examples relevant to healthcare management, which will enable them to improve the provision of care to patients.

Diploma in Healthcare Management

The course equips students with knowledge of the concepts, operational policies and procedures critical in the management of various departments of hospitals and healthcare organizations.

HEALTH INFORMATICS

BSc Degree in Health Informatics

Earning a Health Informatics bachelors can help you gain a broad understanding of vital topics in health informatics and prepare you to take on high-level roles in a variety of healthcare settings. Health informatics jobs are acombination of technology and healthcare. Professionals in this field help collect, analyze, and manage the data that healthcare organizations need to care for their patients. The health informatics field is diverse and expanding, with demand being fueled by the health care industry's focus on evidence-based medicine, quality improvement, and data security and accessibility for patients. Most medical and health services managers have at least a bachlor's degree before entering the field. Master's degrees also are common. Work experience in an administrative or a clinical role in a hospital or other healthcare facility is also common.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE





SCHOOL OF ALLIED HEALTH

Pre hospital emergency care has traditionally been offered by ambulance drivers with very little orno medical education. In other settings hospital staff including nurses and doctors have offered emergency care primarily in inter facility transfers and planned patient transport. Recently health systems are beginning to incorporate structured emergency response systems with qualified emergency care personnel from recognized tertiary health institutions who can offer medical care and technical rescue to assist those who may find themselves in emergen cies requiring urgent medical care and technical rescue. It is with this background that the Emergency Medical Care Department has designed programmes in the emergency medical field to provide an opportunity for those wanting to acquire qualifications in the emergency medical care profession.



Boc Degree in Emergency Medical Care

The 4 year Bachelor's Degree in Emergency Medical Care is designed to produce graduates who can manage patients requiring urgent medical attention using a wide variety of clinical procedures primarily in the out of hospital environment. The program develops graduates who are able to offer emergency care as independent practitioners, offer clinical governance, manage emergencv medical and rescue services, play a role in emergency medical care education and add to the body of knowledge in the health sphere through engaging in research.

Diploma in Emergency Care Technology

This programme is intended to produce emergency care technicians who can provide care as mid-level workers, bridging the gap between the independent Emergency Medical Care practitioner and the supervised basic emergecy medical technician. Their role is to assess, recognize and treat emergencies within their scope of practice.

Duration: 2 years, full time Admission: 34 points Part 1: Course work Part 2: Attachment

Certificate in Emergency Medical Care

The programme is intended to produce medical technicians who can provide basic medical care to patients requiring urgent medical attention. These basic emergency medical technicians are supervised with limited scope of practice.

COUNSELLING

SCHOOL OF ALLIED HEALTH

Botswana like many other countries is engulfed with emotional, health, social as well economic issues that challenge its people. The "helping profession" is one crucial approach central to combating many such problems. The course will offer you step by step guide to counselling practice and take you through counselling process. It will provide you with insightful skills on how to structure and manage therapeutic work in many aspects of the therapeutic relationship.

Certificate in Counselling

Counselling is about training counsellors to help clients resolve personal and interpersonal conflicts, with focus on setting goals and problem solving. The course trains students to provide clients with direction, emotional support and assist them to focus on constructive behaviours. Graduates from this programme can expect to provide services such as counselling, psycho-education, social support, and conducting workshops. Practitioners in this field provide services to a range of sectors including public and private sectors in clinics, hospitals, the nongovernmental sectors and corporate entities.

BA Degree in Counselling

The Degree in Counselling trains students for a wide range of helping and caring professions. The programme is designed with emphasis on the development of whole individual – the personal, interpersonal and professional, thus enabling students to become active professionals. It embraces both the theoretical and practical and is offered over four years with intensive lecture series, research and clinical attachment.

Diploma in Counselling

The programme is arranged such that students can begin to acquire a counselling style tailored to their own personality by familiarizing themselves with major approaches to the therapeutic practice. The programme further fosters the development if critically reflective practitioners who are able to work in variety of settings with a broad range of client groups.

B.Ed Degree in Guidance & Counselling

Guidance and counseling within school settings serve as a supporting function through directing school activities aimed at enhancing learners' psychological adjustment thereby enabling them to perform to the maximum of their capability. The programme is designed to equip professionals with knowledge and skills in delivering guidance education and counselling services in schools and other settings. The programme uses an experiential learning approach where learners are exposed to real-life situations. Learners will to be offered an opportunity to gain competency skills through attachment at various sites where they can learn to provide psychosocial services and assessments to clients.

It is well-tailored to provide a broad understanding of human development and growth, mental health, psychological assessment and diagnosis, life skill education and a wide range of experiences in counseling. It targets individuals with a keen interest in starting or developing their careers in education and human services.

Graduates will be able to apply social sciences, such as sociology, psychology, political science, public health, community development, law, and economics, to engage with various stakeholders in order to develop interventions that solve social and personal problems: and create social change in communities.

BSc Degree in Public Health

BSc in Public Health program equips prospective professionals with a foundational knowledge of the field that will enable them to protect and improve the health of the communities and populations through evaluation of the population's health statistics and the quality of healthcare accessible to them, designing of programs that encourages healthy behaviors, prevention of diseases and injuries, and the control of environmental threats to health ahead of a health crisis. Students are equipped with skills to prepare for, rapidly detect, respond to and recovering from public health emergencies. Moreover, the program prepares students to tackle global health challenges through multidisciplinary coursework, hands-on experiences and research. Graduates emerge ready to address health disparities and promote wellness in diverse settings such as government agencies, non-profits, and healthcare facilities.

MEDICAL RECORDS & TRANSCRIPTION

Diploma in Medical Records & Transcription

The course exposes students to an understanding of medical records and its integral role to patient healthcare quality and effective health planning. Learners who enroll in this programme undertake various core modules to build their knowledge, skills and competencies for quality data collection, storage, retrieval, and use. To fulfill the requirement of the programme, learners must complete nine core modules, medical records project (Disease classification and coding) and work integrated learning.
